Volunteer Information

Volunteers who work a minimum of three shifts will be invited to play in the Supporters and Volunteers outing that will take place the week following the Championship.

Volunteers will be required to purchase uniform shirts (\$25.00 each) which must be worn while on duty. A special for a hat & shirt is (\$30) will also be available. Volunteers will need to supply their own khaki slacks, Bermuda style shorts or skirts. Checks should be made out to SCPC.

You must be at least 18 years old to volunteer.

Volunteer Committees - Off Course

Greeters

Staff hospitality desk at Neshanic Valley Golf Course providing local information to our guests in regards to activities, directions and other special requests. (Fri. 6/15 to Sat. 6/23)

Outside Services

Distribute water, sport beverages and ice to on-course coolers; empty trash receptacles throughout the facility. Volunteers may be required to lift heavy objects. Morning shifts may begin as early as 5:30 a.m. (Fri. 6/15 to Sat. 6/23)

Medical/First Aid

Per USGA requirements, must be a doctor, emergency medical technician, and/or registered nurse. (Sat. 6/15 to Sat. 6/23)

Parking

Assist in the efficient use of all parking facilities at Neshanic Valley GC. Access control and general safety concerns at various restricted areas on site. Work with parking/security committee to direct players, officials, staff and volunteers to designated areas. (Sat. 6/15 to Sat. 6/23)

Player Registration

Assist staff with receiving player information and registering players, taking photos of players, handing out player gifts, and provide general information to players and guests. Volunteers may be asked to assist with organizing Player Information Packets prior to the official opening of Registration. (Fri. 6/15 to Sat. 6/23)

Transportation

Provide transportation for players, officials, and others to and from airport, hotels, and course. Man shuttle stations at each location. Must have valid driver's license, proof of insurance and clean driving record. Coordinate communication between drivers, hotel staff, and players. (Fri. 6/15 to Sat. 6/23)

Volunteer Headquarters

Check in volunteers for the various areas, answering questions, ensuring that the volunteer effort runs smoothly and every volunteer is in the right place at the right time. Coordinate all volunteer meals. Shifts may begin as early as 5:30 a.m. (Fri. 6/15 to Sat. 6/23)

Volunteer Committees - On Course

Marshals/Forecaddies

Stationed at landing zones to assist in spotting errant balls and flagging them; also manage spectators on the course ensuring that appropriate golf etiquette is observed. May also be asked to assist as evacuation drivers. Marshals/Forecaddies must be physically fit. Morning shifts for Marshals/Forecaddies may begin as early as 6:30 am (Mon. 6/18 – Sat. 6/23)

Scoring: Scoreboard

Assist official scorekeeper with various items at official scoreboard, including posting of all scores; collecting and returning scorecards to appropriate area, any other means to assist official scorer with their duties. (Mon. 6/18 – Sat. 6/23)

Scoring: Scorecard Runners

Deliver scorecards from 9th and 18th scoring areas to the appropriate designated area. (Mon. 6/18 – Tues. 6/19)

Scoring: Standard Bearers

Responsible for carrying a two-sided scoring standard sign and for posting the status of the match on the standard. Must be physically fit and able to walk 18 holes. Shifts may vary according to starting times. (Thurs. 6/21 – Sat. 6/23)

Scoring: Walking Scorers

Walk with groups and enter scores, upon completion of each hole, into hand-held electronic scoring device. Must be physically fit and able to walk 18 holes. Shifts may vary according to starting times. (Mon. 6/18 – Thurs. 6/21)

Player Shuttle

Transport groups between green and tee complexes where designated. (Sat. 6/15 - Sat. 6/23)
